- 4. This presentation develops the vocabulary introduced in no. 2 by adding simple descriptions.
- 5. A simple song about a snowman with lots of repetition.
- 6. A longer song but still providing lots of repetition of language.
- 7. A story about Christmas Eve extending the vocabulary previously introduced.
- 8. A traditional carol Away in a Manger

By using the PPs in the recommended order, progression of language is inbuilt.
