

Guidance for using the resources for 'Clothes' Theme

Recommended order for Power Points/Videos

Rationale for the above order:

1. This gives some basic nouns for items of clothing.
2. Using vocab from PP 1, this uses the construction – I am wearing...
3. Building on from PP 1&2, this uses the construction – You are wearing...
4. 4 & 5 can be done in any order as they extend the sentences to – He is wearing.../She is wearing...
5. See 4
6. This PP reinforces items of clothing in a short repetitive story. The habitual future tense is used. E.g When I'm at the park, I wear...
7. This PP uses 'do' (your) and introduces the question 'May I..?' as well as its positive answer – You may...
8. Songs/Rhymes 8-11 can be done in any order given that they are category '2' songs (see below)
9. See 8
10. See 8
11. See 8
12. A song containing more complex language structures that can be used as extension.

By using the PPs in the recommended order, progression of language is inbuilt.

Additional Support

All power points are supported by sound files. Translations are all included in the notes.
NB Some power points are supported by songs.

Songs

The songs have been categorised into 3 levels as follows:

1. Simple songs to start with (particularly suitable for 0-3 but may also be enjoyed by 3-5)
2. Simple songs with more challenging vocabulary (particularly suitable for 3-5 but may also be enjoyed by 0-3)
3. Songs that introduce vocabulary from other themes (e.g. colour) or longer songs

All songs create opportunities for actions and come with the following:

- Gaelic lyrics
- English Translation
- Sound file

Songs highlighted in **blue** have an accompanying online video or DVD (e.g. Cabag)
Songs highlighted in **pink** have a power point with its sound file attached.
